Working Groups allow participants to actively learn about and address topics prioritized during the conversation table dialogues in a workshop-style format ..

Participants will choose which group they'd like to join, and then either travel to breakout rooms or remain with small groups in the ballroom. Facilitators will be available to lead the individual sessions and help participants share knowledge.

### How can I participate in the Working Groups?

Discussant: In the spirit of active learning, all participants are requested to come prepared to contribute personal or project experience relevant to the main conference themes (or in this case governance and institutions and sustaining IW partnerships), and to actively participate in discussion and problem-solving related to priority issues and challenges. Participants should not prepare formal presentations, but instead are warmly encouraged to bring useful knowledge materials for reference and improvised sharing, such as case studies and various project outputs on other media (project films, cd-rom's etc).
