



In February 2009, GETF presented the achievements of Water and Development Alliance (WADA) in 2008 at The Coca-Cola Africa Foundation's (TCCAF) Community Affairs Forum in Cairo, Egypt. At the forum, GETF joined numerous organizations based across the globe that have partnered with Coca-Cola to achieve an impact in the sectors of water, health, entrepreneurship, education, and humanitarian relief. The Water and Development Alliance is a partnership between The Coca-Cola Company and the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID).
