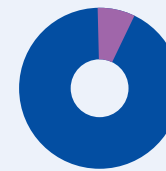

In FY 2023, our most recent audited fiscal year, GETF's program expenses represented 93% of total expenses - with just 7% allocated for management. **That means 93 cents of every US\$ went directly to our programs.**

Our agile program management delivers regional impact and multiple local benefits by:

- Innovating and scaling shared value models

IMPROVING WATER SECURITY ACROSS NORTH AMERICA

In the U.S. and Canada, we manage programs in 15 water-stressed states, 11 critical basins and 4 key agricultural sourcing regions.

- Increasing water and food security for vulnerable American communities
- Improving watershed health and strengthening water utilities
- Championing regenerative farming practices
- Advancing models to sequester carbon via seaweed, improving ocean health and livelihoods



DRIVING COLLECTIVE ACTION, INSIGHT AND IMPACT FUNDING ACROSS LATIN AMERICA

In 19 countries, we are conserving 10 critical basins and expanding clean water access for millions of people in high-need communities.

- Advancing water security region-wide to enable healthy communities
- Reducing water loss and building capacity for 5 water-stressed municipalities
- Accelerating water access in high-need communities, including 600,000+ at-risk women and children
- Scaling nature-based technology to restore and preserve key basins
- Supporting applied science and green financing to scale regenerative dryland solutions
- Helping reduce deforestation and promote regenerative farming in key agricultural supply chains
- Partnering to restore biodiversity through leading innovation



STRENGTHENING AFRICA'S HEALTH AND WATER SYSTEMS WHILE ACCELERATING ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY

In 45+ countries, our partnerships protect critical water resources, increase access to health and water services and provide technical assistance to African institutions and enterprises.

- Improving access and uptake of life-saving medications, vaccines and patient-centered care using proven private-sector approaches
- Improving water security in 60+ priority basins, including WASH service delivery for 7.6MM people
- Strengthening food security, farmer livelihoods and sustainable food systems
- Leveraging commercial best practices, tools, marketing and IP to accelerate health and water security via public-private partnerships
- Providing funding and advisory support to utilities, small businesses and entrepreneurs

CHAMPIONING CIRCULAR ECONOMIES AND INNOVATION IN CENTRAL & EASTERN EUROPE

In 16 countries, we advance water security and economic opportunity, supporting enterprises and improving community resilience and watershed health.

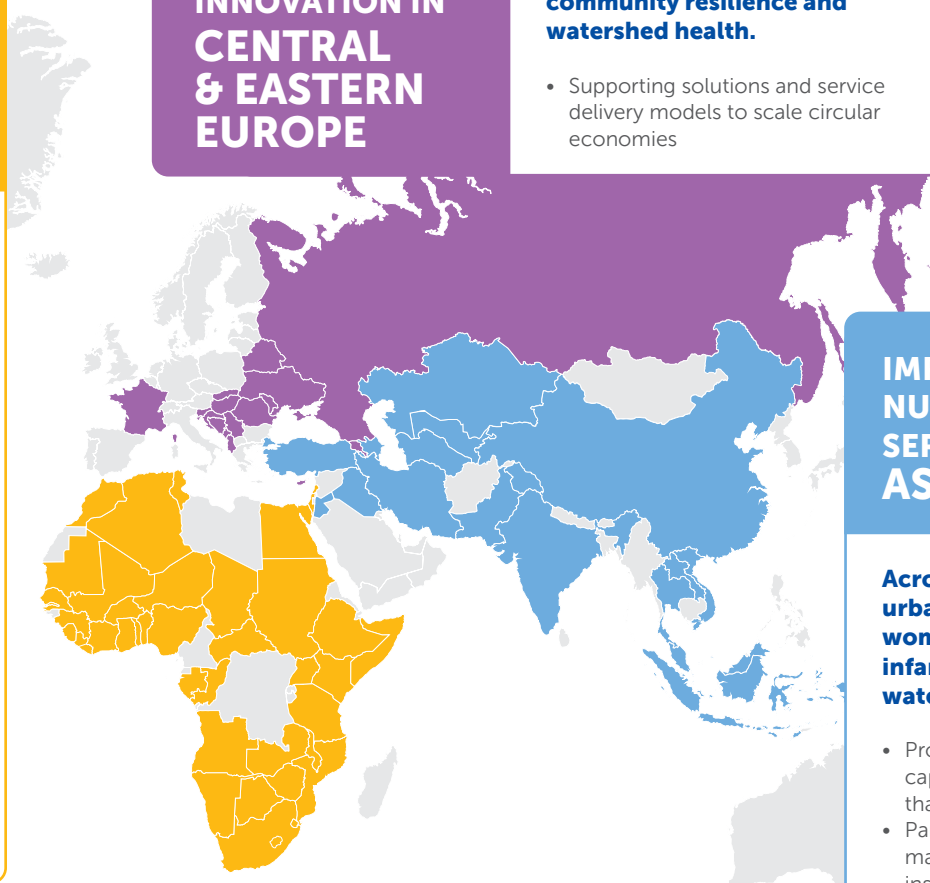
- Supporting solutions and service delivery models to scale circular economies

IMPROVING INFANT NUTRITION AND WATER SERVICE DELIVERY IN ASIA

Across Asia, we help strengthen urban water services, support women's empowerment, address infant malnutrition and restore water to critical basins.

- Providing technical assistance and capacity building for 15 urban utilities that supply water for 21+MM people
- Partnering to take infant nutrition to market - sharing behavior change insight, expanding models, innovating financing and strengthening supply chains
- Supporting water security programming and assurance for corporate partners
